## Full Professor or Assistant Professorship (tenure track) in social and cultural geography (100%)

Job description: The successful candidate will teach a variety of courses at the Bachelor's and Master's level in the Humanities Faculty (teaching load: 4 or 7 periods of 45 minutes per week, each semester). The position is located at the Institute of Geography. The candidate will conduct high-level research in aeography and supervise Master's and Ph.D. theses.

**Requirements:** Applicants must hold a doctorate in geography (or equivalent degree) and demonstrate strong teaching and research skills. The language of instruction is French. Non-French speakers must be able to teach in French after a period of 2 years.
